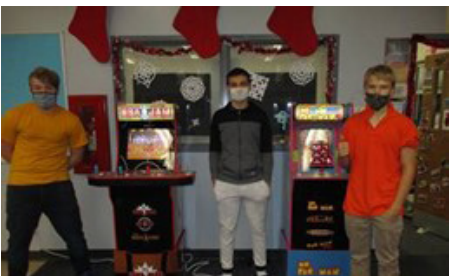

From the Director's Desk

I am pleased to introduce myself as the new Executive Director with Kemmerer Village. During my twenty-eight year history with Kemmerer Village, I have always been very proud to be part of such a dedicated agency.

I moved to Assumption, IL in 1993 from St. Louis to work as a Clinical Supervisor in Marsch Cottage. As you can imagine, this was quite a culture shock, but a welcome change. In St. Louis, I had completed my Masters of Social Work with Washington University. Next, I worked as a therapist with a young children's residential program and in a Crisis Nursery. Because I wanted to be closer to my sister and her family in Springfield, I was eager to move to Assumption to work at Kemmerer Village. My sister had heard of Kemmerer Village through her membership with First Presbyterian Church. My various positions with Kemmerer Village (Clinical Supervisor, Dir. of Quality Assurance, Dir. of Clinical Services, Assistant Executive Director) have deepened my devotion to our Mission. I am honored that the Board of Directors has given me this opportunity to serve our wonderful agency.

Moving forward in 2021 and beyond, I have many hopes for Kemmerer Village. We have adapted successfully to changing environments throughout our 107-year history. Safeguarding the quality of the Kemmerer Village Residential Treatment program honors our past. Focusing on effective planning for our expanding Community Services department is key to our future. We are meeting the challenges of hiring and office expansion for this department. In the fall of 2020, we initiated the development of an Intact Family Service program. This program works to keep children from coming into DCFS care through casework and service provision. The addition of Camp Carew to the Kemmerer Village array of services is also very exciting. I have enjoyed visiting this beautiful setting and meeting with many of the wonderful Camp volunteers. I hope that we will extend Camp Carew's long tradition of providing Christian Camping experiences into the future. I also look forward to increasing usage of the campgrounds outside of the regular camping season. I am confident that Kemmerer Village will continue to serve children and their families in many diverse ways for years to come.

My husband and I have spent the last few years adapting to a less busy schedule with our older children. My twenty-four-year-old son is married and farming locally. His wife and my 20-year-old daughter will finish their nursing degrees at SIUE this coming December. My husband and 22 year old step-son both work with McLane trucking in Taylorville. Although COVID19 has changed the pace of family gatherings, it is important to us to spend time with immediate and extended family.

I am looking forward to hearing from you as I engage in my work as Kemmerer Village's newest Executive Director. Communication with our community partners is a vital part of our work.

The generosity of people like you made it possible for the kids to decorate cookies, make gingerbread houses, have a hot cocoa party and movie night. These special activities made the holiday bright for the children away from their families.

It was very humbling. My grinch attitude could not sustain, my heart grew two sizes. I am so blessed to be a part of the love and value Kemmerer Village gives to the children who rely on us year-round. None of this would be possible without your support. Children’s lives are changed because of people believing in Kemmerer and partnering with us to give children everything they need to succeed.

Autumn was fortunate enough to connect with longtime friend of Kemmerer Village. Former KV employee, Taylorville High School Graduate, Lincoln Land

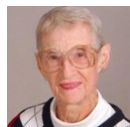

In Remembrance of Former Kemmerer Village Board Members



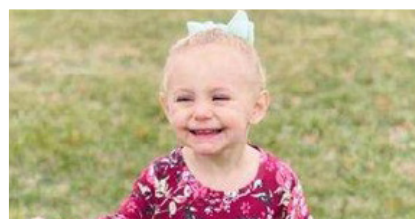
Connie Roegge passed away August 8, 2020. She served on the Kemmerer

Thomas K. Hostetler passed away November 29, 2020 served on

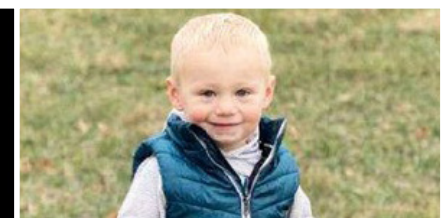

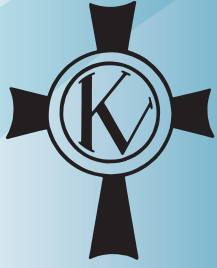
